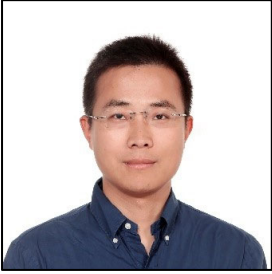


New EDS Distinguished Lecturers Announced
